Event Description

Play a round of disc golf at the Centennial Campus Disc Golf Course anytime from Monday, September 11 - Sunday, September 17. Submit your scores digitally for a chance to win prizes for lowest score, most rounds submitted, and random drawings.

Come to the Centennial Campus Disc Golf Course at 6:00 p.m. on Tuesday, September 12 to complete a round, participate in special contests like closest to the pin and longest putt, and socialize with other disc golf players.

Event Format

- 1. Event Length Monday, September 11 Sunday, September 17
- 2. Participants submit scores by email to wellrec-intramural-sports@ncsu.edu using the digital scorecard found at Hole 1 at the Centennial Disc Golf Course
- 3. Email submissions must include first name/last name/email address to be eligible for prizes.
- 4. Submissions must be received prior to 11:59 p.m. on Sunday, September 17
- 5. Event open to NC State students, faculty, staff, Centennial Campus partners, and Centennial residents

Prizes

Prizes will be awarded for self-submission scorecards for the following:

- 1. Lowest 9-Hole Score (Tiebreaker: the player who holed out a par or better on the majority of holes
- 2. Most 9-Hole Rounds Submitted
- 3. Random Drawings

Special event prizes will be awarded for those competing in person on Tuesday, September 12 at 6:00 p.m. for:

- 1. Closest to the Hole
- 2. Longest Putt

Equipment

1. Intramural Sports will have a limited number of discs participants will be able to use on Tuesday, September 12 at 6:00 p.m. Otherwise, participants are encouraged to bring and play with their own discs or rent them from the Outdoor Adventures Equipment Rental Center.

Game Play

- 1. Only a disc that comes to rest inside the basket constitutes successful completion of that hole
- 2. Players receive a 1-stroke penalty for an unplayable, or lost, disc. These throws must be played from the last known point of the disc, as agreed upon by the group
- 3. There will be no out-of-bounds. Participants will throw from where the disc lies
- 4. Never play unless you have a clear and safe throw

Ground Rules

- 1. Tee throws must be completed in designated tee areas
 - a. Participants are not allowed to step past the front line of the tee box when teeing off
- 2. Fairway throws must be made no closer to the hole than where the previous throw landed
- 3. "Falling" or "jumping" putts are not allowed within 30' of the hole
- 4. A disc that comes to rest more than 6' above ground is unplayable

1	226'	Don't litter. Trash receptacles are located at Fishing Pier. Like regular golf, one stroke is counted each time the disc is thrown. The winner is the golfer with the lowest score. Tee throws must be completed in designate tee areas.
2	318'	5. Fairway throws must be made no closer to the hole than where the previous throw landed. 6. "Falling" or "jumping" putts are not allowed within 30' of the hole.
3	185'	7. Only a disc that comes to rest inside the basket constitutes successful completion of that hole.
4	215'	8. A disc that comes to rest more than 6' above ground is unplayable. 9. Player receives a 1-stroke penalty for a throw out of bounds.
